

# SKULL PATTERN BOOK COVER!

1. Print out the book cover pattern on a sheet of 11 x 17 paper.  
If the book you want to cover is really large, you may want to print out more than one sheet and tape or glue them together to make one larger sheet. Colour some skulls in where appropriate or even inappropriate!
2. Put your book cover down in roughly the center of the blank side of the paper and trace it lightly with a pencil. Put the book aside for now. It knows what it did.
3. Add two inches on the top and on the bottom of the tracing, and four inches on the left and the right side of it.
4. Cut away the excess areas that are beyond your enlarged tracing. Cut them up into really tiny pieces and throw them in the air to celebrate the creation of your book cover.
5. Fold the top and bottom two inch segments down in towards the center.
6. Get the book again and place it on the sheet of paper in the center and then fold the two side flaps over into the inside covers of the book.
7. To make the book cover even more snug you can tape the end flaps to the inside covers of your book with removable tape.
8. Done! Go forth and read from your totally rad school book! It might be really boring, but at least it looks great!
